Uniform Dress Code

Policy

All Students will wear school uniforms to school, on field trips, and school functions-unless otherwise specified.

Implementation

- Parents are responsible for the purchase of uniforms.
- Students shall report to school and school functions wearing their uniform.
- Uniforms shall be in good order: clean, properly fitting, free of rips, stains and missing buttons.
- All students will be in full uniform for chapel.

Schoolwide Rules:

- No visible tattoos.
- No facial piercing jewelry inclusive of ear jewelry on boys.
- No unnatural hair color.

Jewelry Guidelines:

- Jewelry is not permitted in grammar school except the following:
- Grammar girls may wear post or small hoop style earrings. Dangling earrings are not permitted.
- Grammar girls may only wear a necklace with religious significance.

Makeup Guidelines

- Grammar School and Pre-Dialectic girls are not permitted to wear makeup.
- Male students may not wear makeup or nail polish.

Hair Guidelines

- Unnatural hair color (i.e. green, pink, purple, blue, etc.) on any student is not permitted.
- Male students must wear their hair cut above their ears and no longer than the collar of their uniform dress shirt.
- Trendy hairstyles like mohawks, mullets, and rat tails are not permitted. Administration reserves the right to require a change in hair style if its presence is inappropriate or causes unnecessary distraction from the learning environment.

Consequences:

- Failure to have a proper uniform will result in demerits for the students.
- Parents will be notified of uniform infractions.
- Continued failure to resolve uniform issues will result in the student being removed from class and/or school until proper uniform is obtained. Such removal will be recorded as unexcused absences. In such cases, return to school will be dependent upon compliance with school standards.
- Students may be asked to wash/remove make-up or jewelry not suitable.
